

**Guidelines issued to the  
Ethics Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology**

Pursuant to sections 35 and 36 of the Human Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2004 ("the HART Act"), the Advisory Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology (ACART) has issued *Guidelines for family gamete donation, embryo donation, the use of donated eggs with donated sperm and clinic assisted surrogacy* to the Ethics Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology (ECART). ECART is legally required to adhere to the guidelines. The guidelines came into effect on 1 September 2020.
