

Ninth extension of local transition period for the Marlborough District

Presented to the House of Representatives by the Minister for Emergency Management pursuant to section 94D of the Civil Defence Emergency Management Act 2002

Pursuant to section 94D of the Civil Defence Emergency Management Act 2002, I advise the House of Representatives that on 5 April 2022, I received a copy of a notice extending the local transition period covering the Marlborough District for a ninth time. The local transition period came into force on 5 April 2022 and will now end at 12:20pm on 3 May 2022, unless terminated or further extended earlier. A copy of the notice follows on the next page.

Notice of extension of local transition period

Section 94D, Civil Defence Emergency Management Act 2002

I, John Leggett, extend the local transition period over the following geographic areas within the Marlborough District owing to the ongoing recovery requirements from the July 2021 flood event;

1 – Wairau / Awatere Ward

2 – Marlborough Sounds Ward
